

In The Australian Bush



Make your own Australian Bush habitat!

You will need:

- Animal templates
- Colouring pencils or crayons
- Cardboard or an empty box
- Glue
- Scissors
- Paint and Paint brushes

Step 1

Draw or print out pictures of koalas, kangaroos, wombats and other wildlife and colour them in. We have added a few for you below to get you started!

Step 2

Paint the background for your Australian bush – you can either paint it all one colour or get creative and add some detail in too. Once you're happy with it, let it dry.

Step 3

While your background is drying, carefully cut out all the wildlife creatures you'd like to include in your Australian bush habitat!

Step 4

Once the background is dry, add it to the base and sides of your cardboard box using glue or sticky tape.

Step 5

Now it's time to start adding your animals to the bush. Suggestion: You can fold strips of paper and stick them behind the animal to make it pop from the ground or hang in trees.

Step 6

Use your creativity to add any finishing touches. You could make some rocks out of egg cartons, or use crepe paper or wool to create nests and leaves on the floor along the bottom. You could even add some glitter to add a bit of sparkle!
