Different Types of Habitats

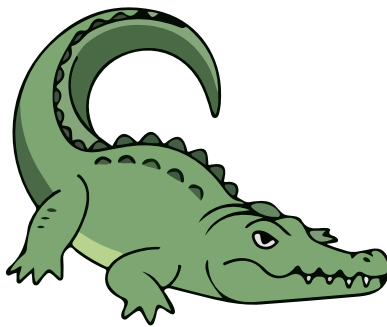
Animals live in different places.

Which animal lives in water?

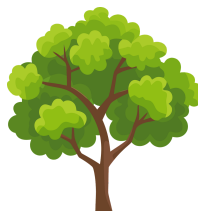

- crawl like a snake

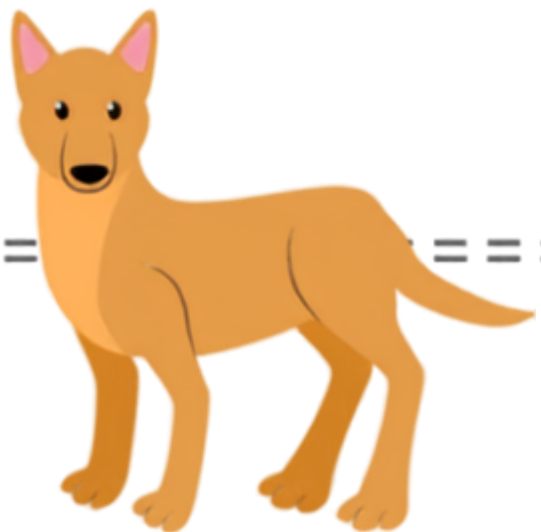
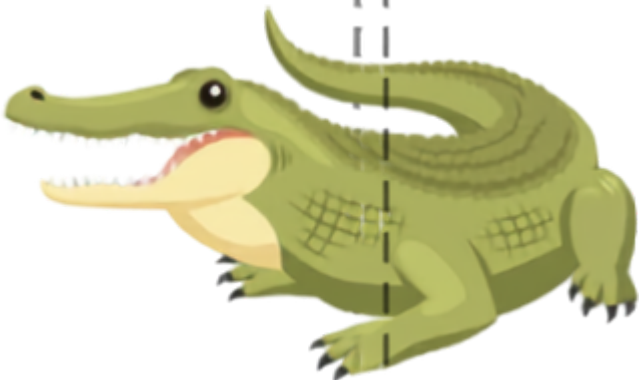

How can we help animals?

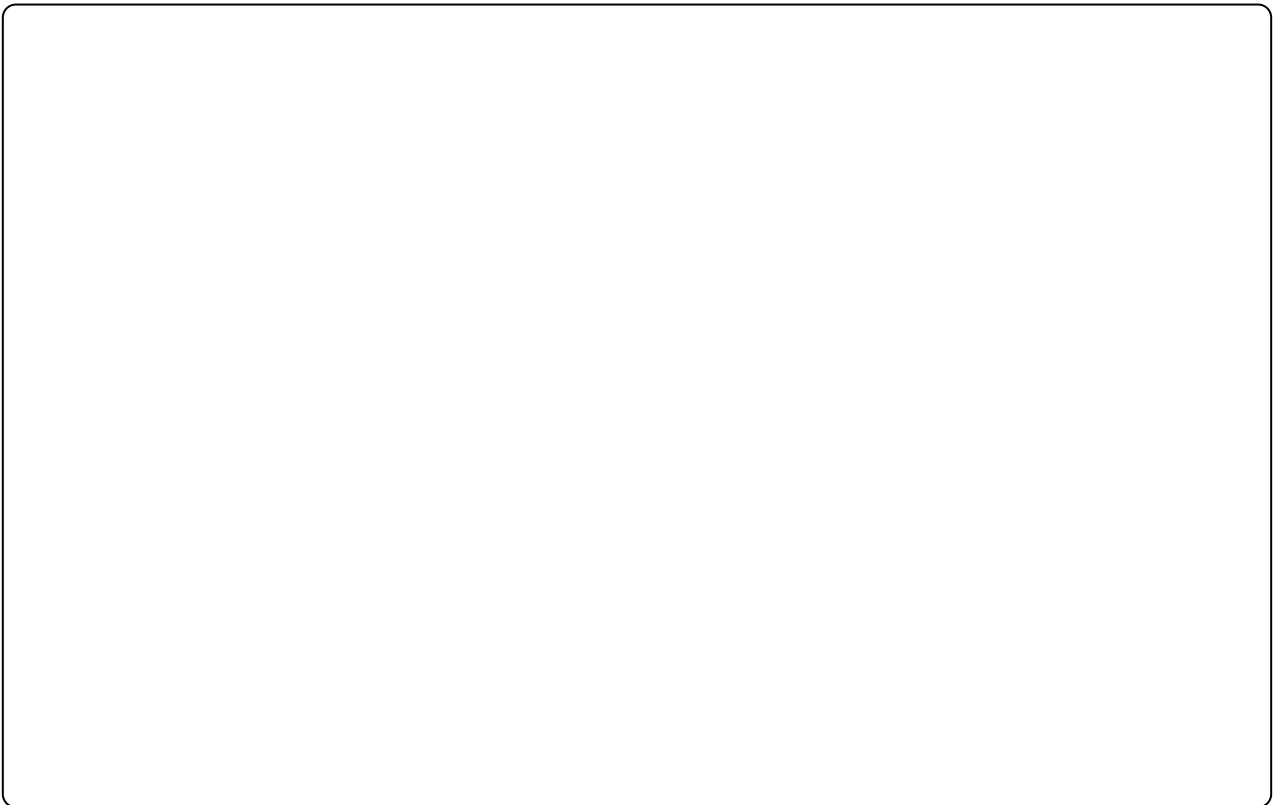

LOOK...

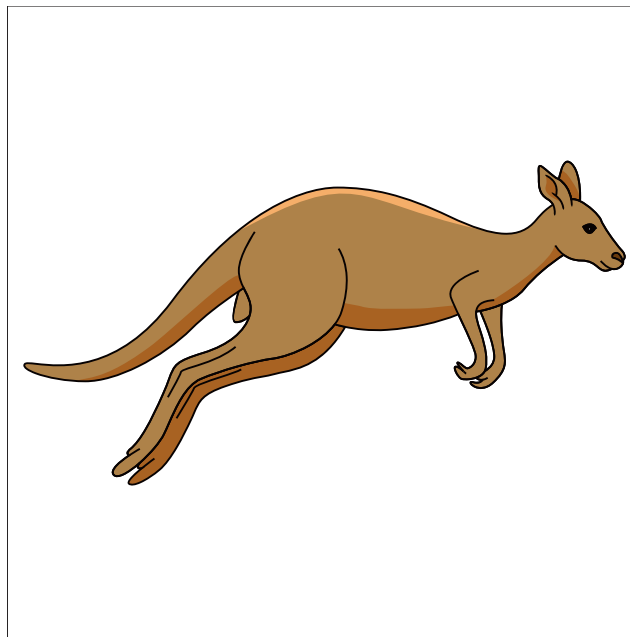
How does the kangaroo move?

It can swim and stay very still.

Why does it live there?

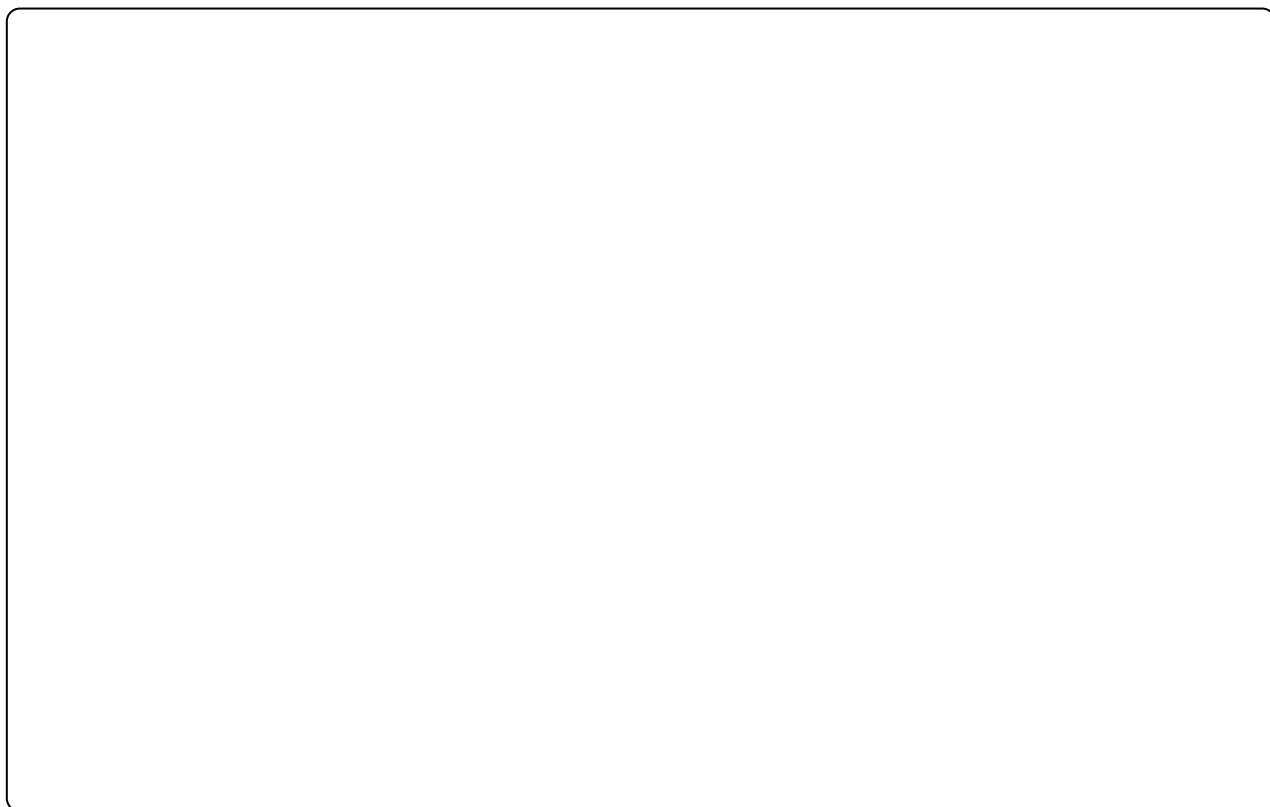
DRAW...
