GROUPING ANIMALS

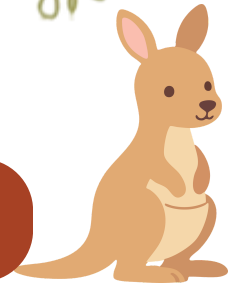


Animal groups

We can group animals.

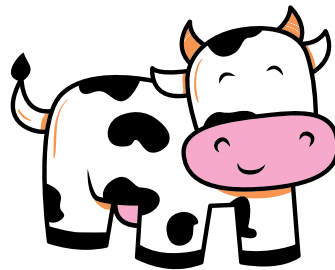
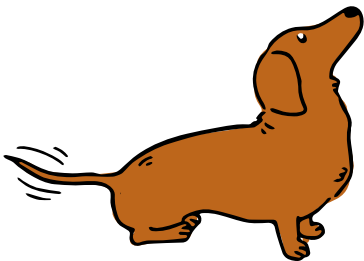
Some animals:

Animal bodies

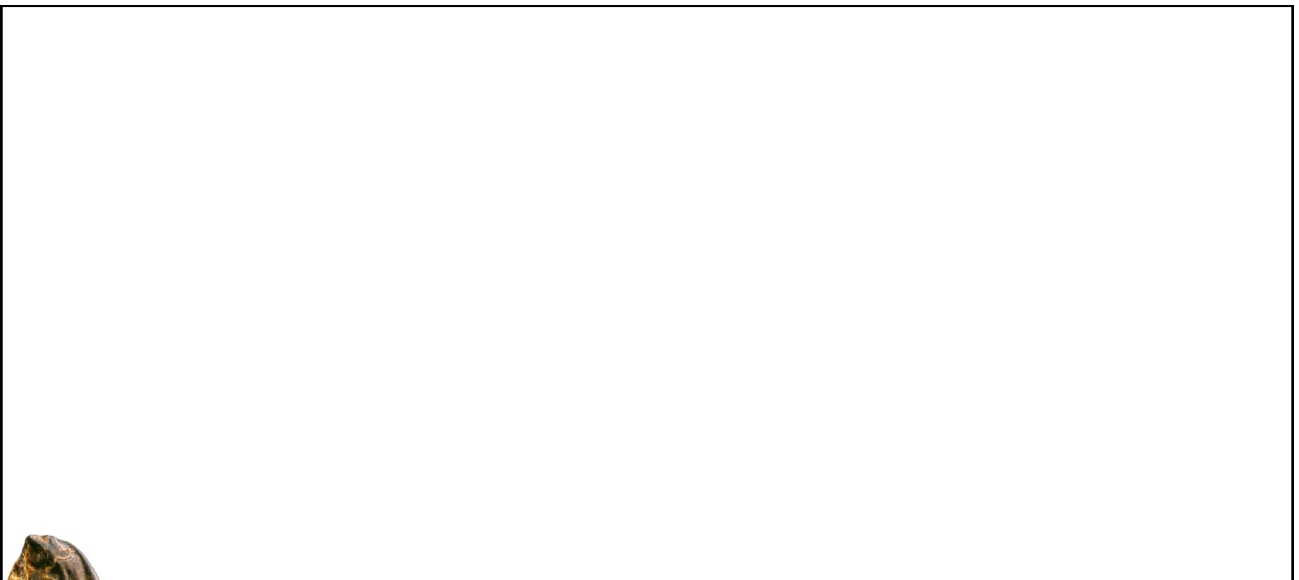
Animals have different body parts.

RAINFOREST ANIMALS

Kangaroos are mammals.

They hop using strong legs.

LOOK...

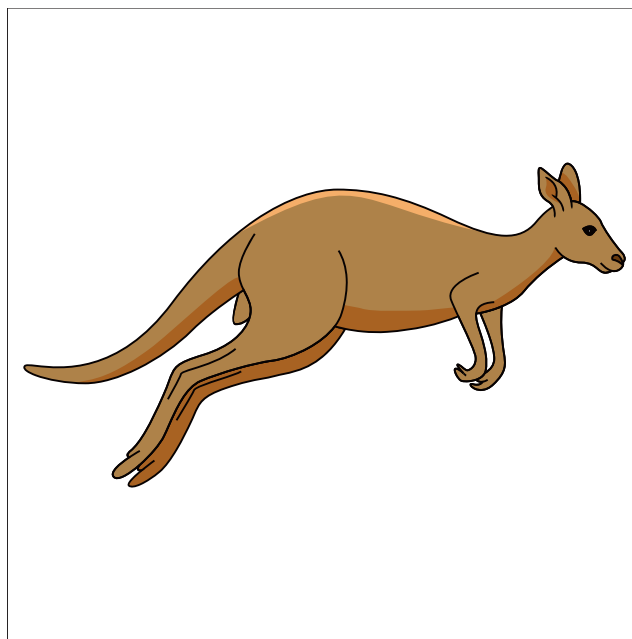
How does it move?

What helps it live in water?

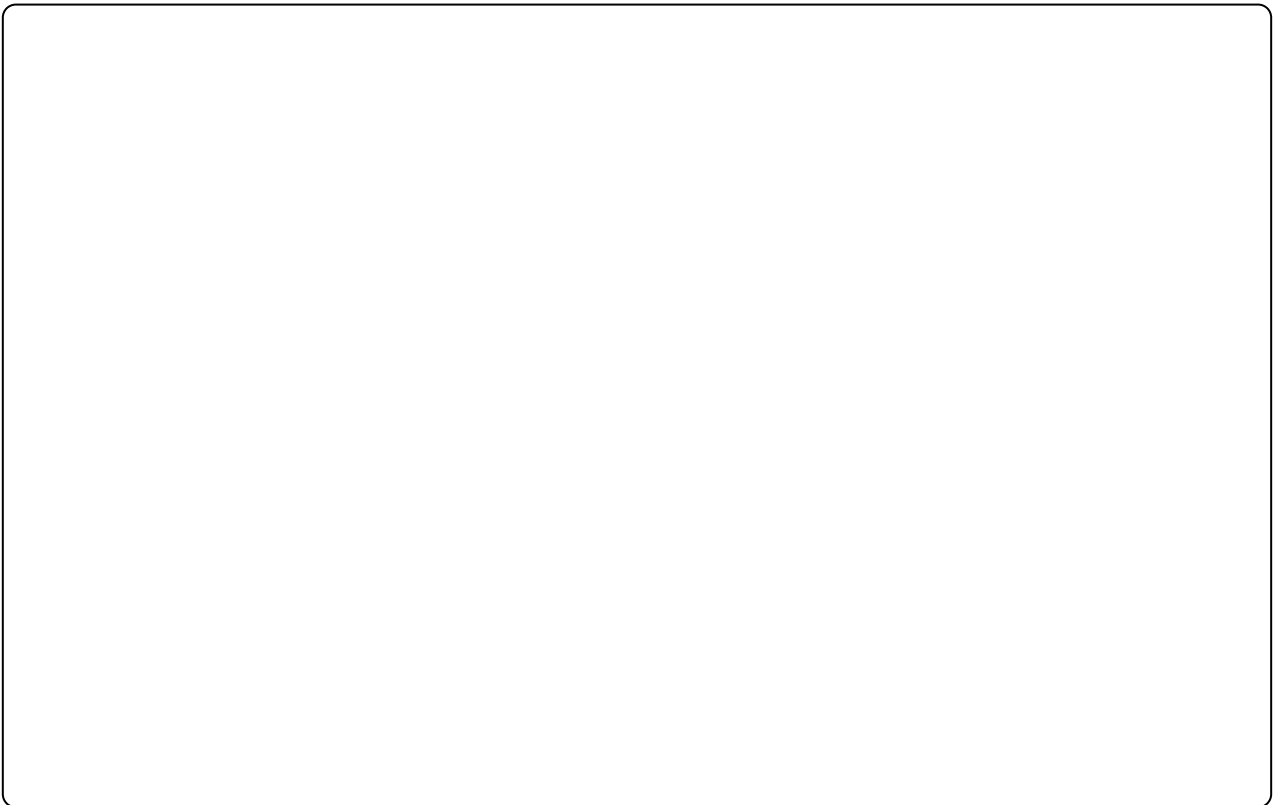
DRAW...
